# Finance Committee

The Finance Committee met on Monday, July 26, 2021 and began the meeting with the selection of a committee Secretary, Nicole Johnston who is new to the committee this year. The committee reviewed the AAPCO painting contract and discussed the body of the contract, the change orders, and the progress to date. We reviewed the payment schedule, payments made to date, and the balance due upon completion of work. Before the last payment is made, there will be an inspection by KB, and presentation of paint warranty by PPG following their examination for paint thickness/cover. A portion of the

final payment will be withheld until the repairs are completed on the rear of the 2200 building and that portion of the painting contract can be completed.

Also, the committee discussed proposals and costs for cleaning of the dryer vents in our units. The Balance Sheet ending June 30, 2021 was discussed and the tool used for the development of the budget this year was reviewed and changes are being made to aid in the development of the 2022 budget.

Our Treasurer is reviewing invoices as they are received to ensure they are posted to the correct accounts. Committee members are paying close attention to the General Maintenance portion of the Operating Budget. Price increases for materials and frequent repairs of facilities are causing that portion of the budget to exceed projections for this point in the year.

The elaeagnus by the Tennis Courts have been trimmed back.

The area behind the 2200 building where the piece of heavy equipment got stuck in the sand / dirt has been repaired by AAPCO.

Thankfully we have suffered no major irrigation line breaks lately.

Our Pine Straw application began on 6/28 and was completed before 7/4.

The trees on the burm that were planted last Fall are doing well.

The laying of sod at the 1400 & 1600 walkways has been completed.

We will be contracting with Fitness Tree to trim our tall palms in late September.
