Trash/Recycle/Misc Item Pick Up

Trash and recycling will not be picked up on Monday September 6th due to it being a holiday. The recycling and trash will be picked up on Tuesday September 7th.

When you have items (appliances, construction debris, furniture, etc.) that you need removed the Town of Kure Beach will do so for a fee. You would need to contact the HOA office whom

will then schedule it with the town. The town picks up these items on Thursday there for you would have to carry your items to the side of the road Wednesday night or early Thursday morning. Please make sure you contact the HOA office FIRST so it can be scheduled. The town will place this fee on the water bill for your building. The HOA will pay it but then the HOA will charge your account for the reimbursement of the fee. Please note maintenance does not move these items to the pick up location as you will have to make the arrangements.

Please don't forget we do have the community dumpster for smaller items. You will need to call the HOA office, 910-239-1370 option 1, to schedule a time for maintenance to meet you at the maintenance shed as they will need to unlock the gate for you. If you are unsure of what items can go in the dumpster please reach out to us for clarification.

Another option is that you can contact a company such as GOT JUNK at 1-800-GOT-JUNK. They are great to work with and sometimes will come the same day you call. They will do all the heavy lifting as well.

The dumpsters that are on the property are for the use by the general contractors hired by ODHOA for work contracted by ODHOA. Please refrain from using them for personal construction debris or personal trash

The events of the past few months have led the Finance Committee (FC) to the realization that the budget for General Maintenance is woefully insufficient to handle day to day operations and the unexpected surprises.

While we wait for our new engineers to do an evaluation of all decks, stairs, and walkways, the FC must propose a budget to the Board of Directors and eventually to the owners, that reflects projections for current operations in addition to a forecast that can fund what will be identified as deck, stairs, and walkway deficiencies on the beachfront properties.

After two years of the FC investigating ways to reduce costs, mainly through seeking competitive bids on existing contracts, there are very few things we can do to offset the high cost of utilities, maintenance, and insurance. By way of an example, the 2021 budget that went into effect in January had a 10% increase for insurance. In late April when bids came in for the period May 2021 through April 2022 the increase was 30% due to the numerous claims that the industry experienced all over the USA (think fires, floods, and hurricanes).

The FC is currently discussing a variety of ways to handle the needed increase for 2022. A survey will be coming soon to assess owner preferences about how to handle the increase

Governing Documents Committee

The Governing Documents Committee has been meeting weekly since May.

We have submitted

our suggestions for updating the Rules & Regulations to the board for a board vote, which, if approved, will be distributed to owners.

We have mostly completed revising and updating the Bylaws but have some legal questions and are awaiting answers from our lawyers before we can submit that update to the board.

The process for the Bylaws update is (1) board approval of the draft, (2) legal approval of the draft, and (3) the draft goes out to the owners for a vote.

This time around, the Bylaws amendment will consist of the entire Bylaws document, with changes highlighted for ease of understanding. (Experts suggest doing it this way after an association has done many amendments consisting of delete this section and add this section, which we have done in the past.)



Long Range Planning Committee

The LRPC has been meeting every two weeks since we began in June. We currently have 12 members on the committee, covering 14 asset categories. We have been busy collecting data, including cost estimates and historical data that is required to put together the final Long Range Plan.

Most of our work will be done soon, except for completing a schedule for the next buildings to be redecked, painted and/or repaired. It is critical that we get professional guidance to determine a schedule for redecking. Our decks are a top safety concern. We have engaged SKA engineering for this task. We do not expect to have a completed report until late in the year. The LRP will be updated again at that time.

An updated LRP will be posted on the website soon. As always, feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns.
